Part-time and Full-Time Teacher Pool. Single-semester and year-long appointments as enrollment demand, sabbaticals, leaves of absence and other staffing needs arise. Courses, usually lower division, available teaching across the curriculum to include public speaking, persuasion, interpersonal, organizational, intercultural communication, electronic media production or small group communication. Fall 2008 – Summer 2009.

QUALIFICATIONS: Required: MA or MS degree in Communication Studies or a related area, with college teaching experience (or equivalent with college-age students). BA or BS with at least 10 years professional artistic experience may be substituted for Masters for rare appointments in area of film-making. Preferred: Ph.D. M. Divinity or J.D. with appropriate teaching or training experience considered.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Lower division teaching, holding office hours

SALARY: \$4605/course minimum
